

## PROTECTION MEASURES FOR OUR VISITORS

---

### to contain the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2

We are looking forward to your visit with us. Your safety and that of our employees has the highest priority for us. We would like to give you an overview of our offer, our protective measures and the applicable rules of conduct. Please refrain from a visit if you feel ill.

#### General information

- › The maximum number of visitors in the building is 300 people.
- › The opening hours are basically unchanged. For additional cleaning the experimenta is closed on weekdays from 12:30 p.m. to 13:30 p.m. and on weekends and public holidays from 13:30 p.m. to 14:30 p.m.
- › The visiting hours are limited. Tickets are valid on the respective day either for the morning or the afternoon.



#### To the offer:

Some of the interactive stations remain out of service for reasons of infection protection. Around 200 of the 275 interactive stations are available to you. In particular, stations dealing with wind and water will not be opened. This leads to restrictions especially in our ForscherLand (4th floor), which has offers for our younger guests up to 10 years old. The studios on the exhibition floors ForscherLand and StoffWechsel are also not accessible. **The experiment theater and the observatory remain closed.**

#### Only online tickets

Ticket booking is currently only possible online and in advance. Please bring a printed copy of your ticket with you. It is only valid for the specified time slot.

#### Mouth and nose protection (Duty to wear masks)

For all visitors from the age of 6 years are required to wear a mask. Our employees are also instructed to wear a mouth and nose protection mask.



#### Hygiene

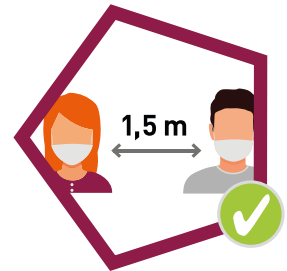
- › Please follow the general rules of hand hygiene. Enough washing facilities are available in the toilets in the building. You will also find dispensers with disinfectant on every floor so that you can regularly disinfect your hands before entering the exhibition areas. Descriptions for correct and thorough cleaning can be found on every washing facility and disinfectant dispenser.
- › Also observe the rules for coughing and sneezing (keep your distance, turn away, sneeze/cough in tissue or crook of your arm, wash your hands.)

## PROTECTIVE MEASURES FOR OUR VISITORS

#### Distance rules

- › The legally prescribed minimum distance of 1.50 m must be observed. A special guidance system (floor markings, barriers, etc.) is installed throughout the building in order to be able to comply with these requirements. This applies in particular to the entrance area. Please note the corresponding markings.
- › The routing in the exhibitions is a one-way street principle through the exhibition; entrances and exits on the floors are separated.
- › Please note that group formations are only allowed if they are persons from a household and the number of persons is adapted to the localities. You will also find special instructions for this in the relevant sections.
- › The use of the seating facilities is permitted alone or with people from the same household.



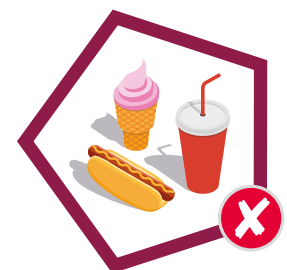
#### Cleaning

The cleaning intervals in the house are increased. The basic cleaning takes place before the opening, during the lunch break and after closing. The interaction surfaces and frequently touched surfaces such as door handles are cleaned several times a day.

#### Food and Drink

The consumption of food is not allowed. The restaurant in the experimenta is open daily from 10:00 a.m. to 18:30 p.m.

There are hot meals available throughout the day.
